

The Reverend David Lewis RIP

It is with great sadness that I announce the sudden and unexpected death of the Reverend David Lewis aged 58 on Monday 9 September 2019.

David is believed to have died while out jogging near the village of Elmley Castle where he lived. He had been rector in the Diocese of Worcester for the past eighteen months, previously spending fourteen years ministering in the Diocese of Ripon and Leeds and latterly the new Diocese of Leeds. David served in the East Richmond Team Ministry group and was Rector of the Benefice of the Wiske until he moved to the Diocese of Worcester. The Bishop of Worcester, Dr John Inge, said: 'David was an outstanding priest who had won the hearts of all those to whom he ministered in the months since he came to this diocese. His untimely death is a terrible tragedy and he will be greatly missed. Very many people, myself included, had profound affection and respect for him.

Our thoughts and prayers are with all who mourn his passing, particularly his mother, his brothers and their families.'

We in the benefice of the Wiske pray for David's family who have suffered a great loss. We all feel their loss and support them in it. In our sorrow we turn to Christ, who is the Shepherd and guardian of our souls.

David believed in Christ the Good Shepherd: may he now enjoy the fullness of eternal life in the kingdom of heaven. AMEN.

This term is set to be a busy one so there will be lots to report back on over the next few months!







As previously publicised, the **SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING** of the East Cowton New Village Hall Association took place on the 5th September. The basic intention was to take some steps towards improving the **ECNVHA's** chances of achieving that elusive Big Grant we need in order to build a new hall.

The meeting took a first step in passing the following motion:



"This meeting of The East Cowton New Village Hall Association agrees in principle the intention to convert to a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (a **CIO**) and with legal advice, working group from the Executive Committee to proceed with drawing up the necessary documents and for these to be presented at a further SGM." 18 for, 0 against, 2 abstentions.

So, a lot of work to do and eventually another SGM to move, if thought the best way to go (which is likely), towards making the necessary changes to the current constitution of the **ECNVHA** in order to convert to a '*CIO*' style constitution. Watch out for another **SGM**!

The rise of self-employment

Those aged over 50 now make up nearly half of all self-employed workers. That is about 2.27 million people, up from 1.45 million a decade ago. And almost one in five of the self-employed work-force is over 60. With a rising state pension age and a longer life expectancy, they need the money. But companies tend to discriminate against older people who have had to take time out of their careers, perhaps to look after grandchildren or an elderly relative. So many older people have no choice but to venture into the world of self-employment, to make ends meet. But it's not all bad news. Researchers point out: "Self-employment can offer opportunities for flexible, fulfilling and rewarding work." The study was done by Rest Less, a jobs and advice site catering for older people.


